- Scout Medical Form A & B (including **current** immunization information)

 - o Form C (physical) is due annually and can be on a different date cycle
- Scout Insurance Card (copy of both sides)
- Parent/Guardian Medical Form A & B (required to attend any campout)
 - o Form C (physical) is due annually (required to attend campout over 72 hours)
- Parent/Guardian Insurance Card (copy of both sides) (required to attend any campout)
- Check for \$220* made out to “**BSA Troop 33**” (see breakdown below)
 - o \$ 35 Scout BSA Registration (\$33), BSA Insurance (\$1) & Unit Liability Insurance (\$1)
 - o \$ 34 1st Adult BSA Registration (\$33) & BSA Insurance (\$1)
 - o \$ 12 Boy's Life Magazine Subscription
 - o \$ 18 Popcorn Fundraiser (1 box required purchase to be delivered in November 2018)
 - o \$121 Troop Dues (covers supplies, merit badge & advancement patches, etc)
 - o \$220 - Total
 - o * Add \$34, (\$254 total), if registering 2 adults for your first Scout
 - o * Deduct \$34, (\$186 total), if this package is for your second Scout
 - o * Deduct \$35 if transferring from Pack (Active Registered Webelos in 2018)
 - o * Deduct \$34 if transferring from Pack (Active Registered Adult in 2018)

Registered adults must maintain current YPT certification, (Youth Protection Training), which needs to be repeated online every two years. Additionally, other online training videos can be taken, such as Troop Committee Challenge, Safe Swim, Hazardous Weather, etc. Go to my.scouting.org and login to your account to take the training courses.

Parent participation in leadership and support roles is **required** for our troop to continue to thrive. We have many opportunities to serve. Your Scout's experience is as good as **you** make it!
