DESCRIPTION: Calico is an old West mining town founded in 1881 during the largest silver strike in California. With its 500 mines, Calico produced over \$20 million in silver ore over a 12-year span. When silver lost its value in the mid-1890's, Calico became a "ghost town." Walter Knott purchased Calico in the 1950's architecturally restoring all but the five original buildings. Calico is now a State Historical Landmark. Today, the park offers the opportunity to share in its rich history and enjoy the natural beauty of the surrounding desert environment. Scouts will tent camp so “be prepared” for cold weather.
