DESCRIPTION: At this campout, Troop 33 will be hiking the Mt. Baden Powell Trail. This 8 mile roundtrip trail honors Lord Baden Powell, a British Army officer who founded the Boy Scout Movement in 1907. The campground sits at a 7500-foot elevation. In addition to the campfires, cook-outs, skits, and other fun activities, the scouts will be able to enjoy the wildlife, plants, and scenery of this region.

Scouts are responsible for packing their own trail lunch for Saturday. They will also need to wear hiking boots and have a day pack (similar to what they use for books at school) for the hike. They must have their ten essentials, lunch and extra water in their day pack.

Trail Lunch Ideas / Day Hike Information

1 Liter/Quart Water
 Trail Mix – peanuts, cashews, almonds, raisins, dried fruits, M&M's, gold fish, crackers, mini pretzels, wheat/rice/corn Chex, Granola, etc.
 Cliff Bars, Granola Bars
 Beef Jerky, Beef Stick, Dried Salami, Sardines, Canned Tuna, Vienna Sausages
 Ritz, Crackers, Animal Crackers, Graham Crackers, Pop Tarts, Fig Newton's
 Apple, Orange
 Pack lunch in gallon size Ziploc freezer bag

3. Extra Clothing (sweater or warm jacket)
4. Rain Gear (light weight poncho)
5. Water bottle
6. Flashlight (w/extra batteries in plastic bag)

9. Sun protection (hat, sunglasses, sun screen)
10. Map and compass
